(the “**Company**”) announces that the 2017 annual general meeting of the Company (the “**2017 AGM**”) was held on Wednesday, 30 May 2018, at which the resolutions set out in the notice of the 2017 AGM were voted by poll and passed. For the details of the resolutions considered at the 2017 AGM, please refer to the circular of the 2017 AGM of the Company dated 10 May 2018 (the “**Circular**”). Unless otherwise defined in this announcement, capitalized terms used in this announcement shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular. The poll results are set out below:

The total number of Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the resolutions or abstain from voting at the 2017 AGM was 12,642,380,000 Shares, which was the total number of issued Shares as at the date of the 2017 AGM. Shareholders and authorized proxies holding aggregate 11,602,904,431 Shares were present at the 2017 AGM.

No party has stated its intention in the Circular that it would vote against any resolution or abstain from voting at the 2017 AGM. To the best knowledge, information and belief of the Directors, there was no restriction on any Shareholder casting votes on any of the proposed resolutions at the 2017 AGM. There was no Share entitling the Shareholders to attend but abstain from voting in favor of the resolutions as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules, and no Shareholders were required to abstain from voting on any of the resolutions at the 2017 AGM under the Listing Rules. The convening of the 2017 AGM complied with the relevant laws and regulations of the PRC, the Listing Rules, and the Articles of Association. Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, the Company's H share registrar, was appointed as the scrutineer for the voting at the 2017 AGM.

## **PAYMENT OF FINAL DIVIDEND**

### **Final Dividend**

The resolution in relation to profit distribution plan for the year 2017 was duly approved by Shareholders at the 2017 AGM. For the full context of the resolution, please refer to the Circular.

The final dividend to be distributed by the Company for the year ended 31 December 2017 is RMB0.7585 per 10 Shares (inclusive of tax). The net profit of the Group at the end of 2017 amounted to RMB2,130,963,543, and the total amount of profit distribution amounted to RMB958,924,523, which accounted for 45% of the net profit of the Group for the year 2017. In principle, payments will be made to holders of Domestic Shares in Renminbi and holders of H Shares in Hong Kong dollars. The exchange rate of Hong Kong dollars will be the average closing price of Hong Kong dollars against RMB announced by the People's Bank of China for the five working days prior to the date of the 2017 AGM (i.e. HK\$1 = RMB0.815352). As such, the final dividend per H Share amounted to HK\$0.0930 (inclusive of tax). The final dividend is currently expected to be paid on Tuesday, 10 July 2018 to the Shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Monday, 11 June 2018.

For determining the entitlement of the Shareholders to the final dividend for the year 2017, the register of members of the Company will be closed from Wednesday, 6 June 2018 to Monday, 11 June 2018, both days inclusive, during which period no transfer of Shares will be registered. Shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Monday, 11 June 2018 are entitled to the final dividend for the year 2017. In order to be entitled to the final dividend for the year 2017, unregistered holders of H Shares must deposit the transfer documents with the Company's H share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong no later than 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, 5 June 2018.

The Company has appointed Computershare Hong Kong Trustees Limited as the receiving agent of H Share dividends (the “**Receiving Agent**”), who will pay the declared dividend to the Receiving Agent for their onward payment to holders of H Shares. The Receiving Agent will pay the cash dividend, and the cheques of the cash dividend will be dispatched to the holders of H Shares by the Company’s H share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited no later than Tuesday, 10 July 2018 by ordinary post, while the risk of the delivery shall be borne by holders of H Shares.

## **Taxation**

Pursuant to the PRC Individual Income Tax Law (《中華人民共和國個人所得稅法》), the Implementation Regulations of the Individual Income Tax Law (《中華人民共和國個人所得稅法實施條例》), Notice on the Issues Concerning the Collection and Administration of Individual Income Tax Following the Repeal of Guo Shui Fa [1993] No. 45 (Guo Shui Han [2011] No. 348) (《國家稅務總局關於國稅發[1993]045號文件廢止後有關個人所得稅徵管問題的通知》(國稅函[2011]348號)) and Announcement of the State Administration of Taxation on Promulgation of the Administrative Measures on Entitlement of Non-residents to Treatment under Tax Treaties (Announcement No. 60 [2015] of the State Administration of Taxation) (《國家稅務總局關於發佈〈非居民納稅人享受稅收協定待遇管理辦法〉的公告》(國家稅務總局公告2015年第60號)) and relevant laws, regulations and regulatory documents, the Company shall, as a withholding agent, withhold and pay individual income tax for the individual H Shares holders in respect of the 2017 H Shares final dividend to be distributed to them. Overseas resident individual shareholders of stocks issued by domestic non-foreign investment enterprises in Hong Kong are entitled to the relevant preferential tax treatment pursuant to the provisions in the tax agreements signed between the countries in which they are residents and the PRC, or to the tax arrangements between mainland China and Hong Kong and Macau. Accordingly, 10% of the dividends to be distributed to the individual H Shares holders are generally withheld as individual income tax unless otherwise specified by the relevant tax laws, regulations and tax agreements.

For holders of H Shares who are non-resident enterprises, in accordance with the provisions of the Notice on Issues concerning Withholding and Paying the Enterprise Income Tax on Dividends Paid by Chinese Resident Enterprises to H Shares holders who are Overseas Non-resident Enterprises (Guo Shui Han [2008] No. 897) published by the State Administration of Taxation of the PRC (國家稅務總局《關於中國居民企業向境外H股非居民企業股東派發股息代扣代繳企業所得稅有關問題的通知》(國稅函[2008]897號)), the enterprise income tax shall be withheld at a uniform rate of 10% by the Company. Non-resident enterprise shareholders may apply for tax refund for the difference in accordance with relevant requirements including tax agreements (arrangements) upon the receipt of dividends.

For investors of the Shenzhen Stock Exchange (including enterprises and individuals) investing in the H Shares of the Company listed on the Stock Exchange (the “**Southbound Trading**”), the Shenzhen Branch of China Securities Depository and Clearing Corporation Limited, as the nominee of the H Shares holders for Southbound Trading, will receive all cash dividends distributed by the Company and distribute the cash dividends to the relevant investors of H Shares of Southbound Trading through its depository and clearing system.

The cash dividends for the investors of H Shares of Southbound Trading will be paid in RMB. Pursuant to the relevant requirements under the Notice on the Tax Policies Related to the Pilot Program of the Shenzhen-Hong Kong Stock Connect (Cai Shui [2016] No. 127) (《關於深港股票市場交易互聯互通機制試點有關稅收政策的通知》(財稅[2016]127號)) promulgated by Ministry of Finance of the PRC, State Administration of Taxation and China Securities Regulatory Commission on 5 November 2016:

1. For dividends received by domestic investors from investing in H Shares listed on the Stock Exchange through Shenzhen-Hong Kong Stock Connect, the company of such H Shares shall withhold and pay individual income tax at the rate of 20% on behalf of the investors of the Company. Individual investors may, by producing valid tax payment proofs, apply to the competent tax authority of China Securities Depository and Clearing Corporation Limited for tax credit relating to the withholding tax already paid abroad.
2. For dividends received by domestic enterprise investors from investing in Shares listed on the Stock Exchange through Shenzhen-Hong Kong Stock Connect, such amount shall be reckoned in their gross revenue and subject to corporate income tax pursuant to laws. In particular, for the dividends obtained by mainland resident enterprises from holding relevant H Shares for consecutive 12 months, the corporate income taxes shall be exempted pursuant to laws. The company of such H Shares will not withhold and pay the income tax of dividends for domestic enterprise investors and those domestic enterprise investors shall report and pay the relevant tax themselves. When declaring and paying enterprise income tax themselves, mainland corporate investors may apply for tax credit pursuant to laws in respect of dividend income tax which has been withheld and paid by non-H stock companies listed on the Stock Exchange.

The time arrangement including record date and the date of cash dividend distribution for investors of the Southbound Trading is same as those of the holders of H Shares.

If holders of H Shares have any queries on the above arrangements, they should seek advice from their tax advisors on the tax impact in the PRC, Hong Kong and other country(ies) or region(s) in relation to the holding and disposing of H Shares.
